

## Overview

We are happy to present the highlights of our PLMS activities in year 2018-19. In the academic year 2018-19, we carried out two major projects - PRAVINYA Learning Management System (PLMS) and PRAVINYA Sujaya English Enrichment (P-SEE) program in Telangana State. We continue to be privately funded and do not accept funding from any government authority or agency.

We reached PLMS to 788 schools and conducted P-SEE in 32 schools and released PLMS Ver 10 with 1879 modules. All activities were carried out in 13 districts of Telangana in partnership with the district education authorities, ITDA (Integrated Tribal Development Agency) and two Foundations.

Under the PLMS program, we actively encourage schools to

- use computers with PLMS for integrated teaching (Classroom teaching plus digital classes)
- upgrade teacher skills
- regularly ensure maintenance of their computers,
- involve community to actively contribute towards further enhancing the educational opportunities

Under the PSEE – Program, we conduct one day English Workshops to

- Provide a structured approach to English learning through digital modules
- encourage active participation by the English Teacher in using blended teaching methods
- engage all students in the workshop
- expose students to the vast variety of English modules
- create awareness among students regarding concept of Discourses

We are happy to share with you details of these activities.

## Key Highlights

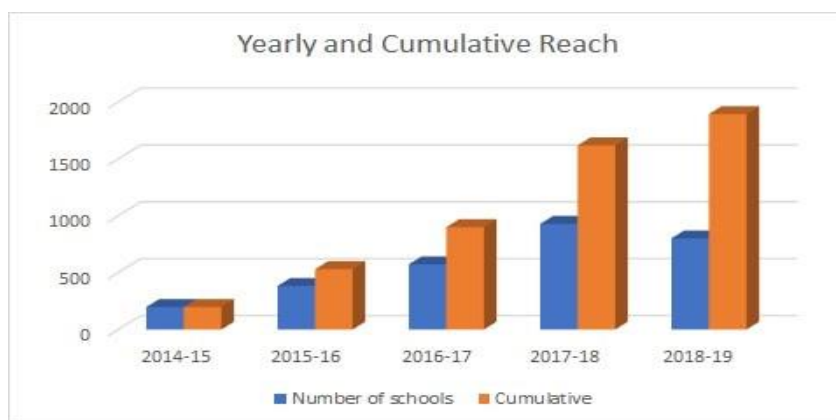


Figure 1 - Comparative year-wise reach of schools

- **Cumulative reach of PLMS reach** schools 1,873 as on 31<sup>st</sup> march, 2019. Figure 1 shows a comparative annual growth over years

- **PLMS Ver 10** - containing 1,879 modules (videos/ animations/ simulations/interactive) mapped to classes 2nd to 10th (as per TS syllabus) in Telugu and English medium was released during the year 2018-19

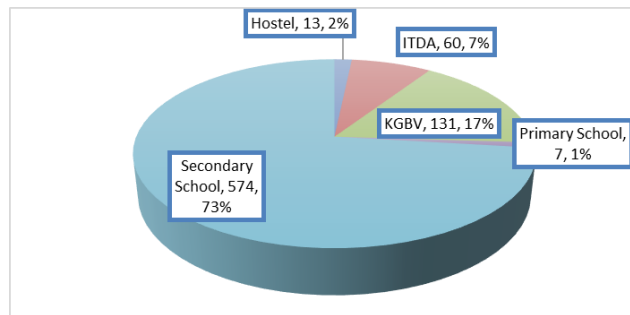


Figure 2- Distribution of PLMS across school types

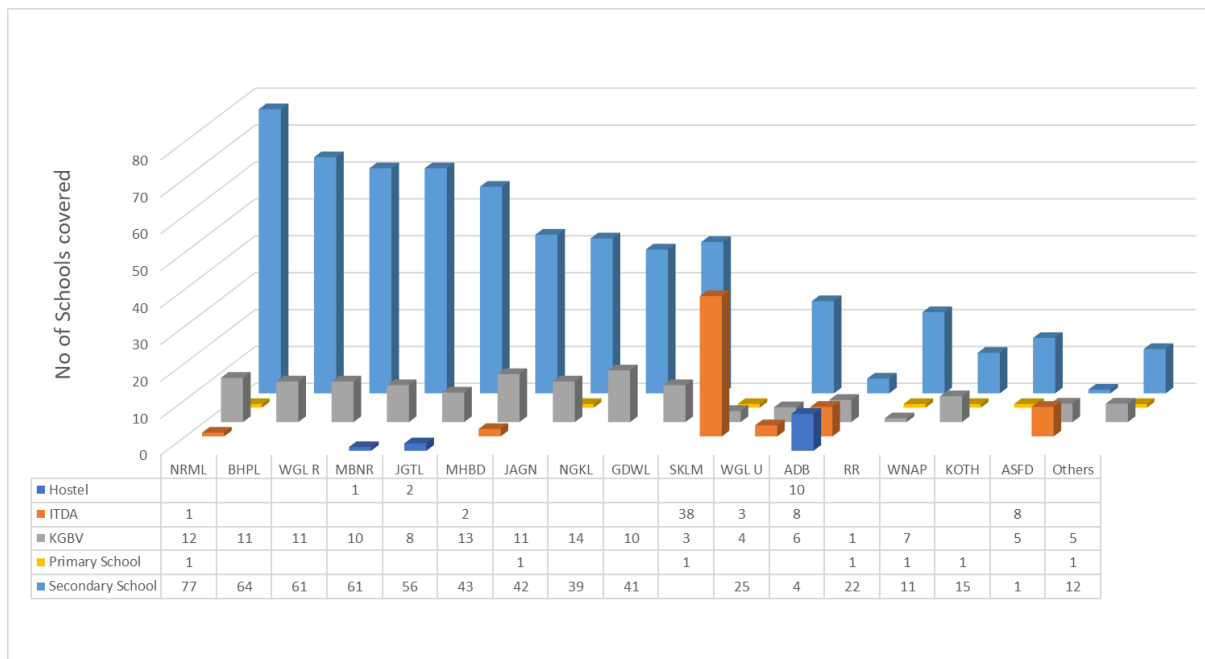


Figure 3- School type-wise District-wise PLMS

- **Reach during the year 2018-19** - During the year, we collaborated with district authorities of 13 districts, State authority of ITDA (Tribal Development of Telangana) and 2 CSRs. Table 1 provides information about the activity during the year. Figure 2 shows distribution across school types and Figure 3 shows the school type-wise district-wise reach.

- Dissemination of third party content as part of PLMS
  - Content from SIET Hyderabad. During the year we received content from SIET in two lots-
    - **305** modules were received in **June 2018** and included in PLMS Ver 10
    - **236** modules were received in **Jan 2019** and will be included in PLMS Ver 11.
  - Sujaya Content (Audio Clips/English Grammar/Textbook Based Grammar) in collaboration with SUJAYA Foundation – Mumbai.
  - OLabs (Science animations and simulations) in an offline mode in collaboration with C-DAC, Government of India
  - ToonMasti (EVS and Maths content in animated videos format) for Primary classes in collaboration with EYF (which is the CSR arm of consulting firm E & Y).

## PRAVINYA Support Services

PLMS service desk offered support services to Schools during the year 2018-19. The services include

- **Online/ phone troubleshooting to schools** - We received **576** calls from the school teachers, of which 423 were solved (73%) and 37 were Requests for PLMS (6%).
- **Follow up calls to schools** - to monitor and encourage usage – During the year, our team made **390 calls** and received responses regarding PLMS usage.
- **Centralized logs monitoring** – We have collected over **250 logs** to monitor actual usage in schools.

## Plans for Academic year 2019-20

- PLMS in 500 new schools and upgrades in selected existing schools.
- More P-SEE Workshops - Mathematics and English, in schools with PLMS.
- Digital content usage Assessment from teachers and learning outcome evaluation of students
- More focus on PLMS Usage in schools
- Release of PLMS Ver 11
- Best PLMS Award 2018-19 will be commenced from July-2019.
